




A tourist town, City of Art and History and candidate city for UNESCO World Heritage status, Le Mans has strong economic, tourist, historical and heritage potential. The automobile capital since the 19th century, Le Mans is deliberately looking to the future and enjoys a number of geographical and strategic advantages. The city stands at a crossroads of major motorway and road routes, making it essential for national (Normandy, Brittany, Pays de la Loire, Paris / Ile-de-France, Centre, Poitou-Charentes) and international trade. One of Le Mans' historical assets is its shared history with Normandy and Anjou, in particular through the Plantagenet family, of which Geoffrey V, known as Geoffrey the Fair, was the first member of this dynasty. His son Henry II, King of England, was born in Le Mans and made the Palais Comtal a major residence of his kingdom. Saint-Julien Cathedral is a must-see in the city and is open all year round, for self-guided and guided tours. Another attraction in Le Mans: the world-famous 24 Hours race, considered in 2012 by National Geographic to be the world's leading sporting event, ahead of the Olympic Games. This race builds «a bridge between past and present»...

THE HISTORIC HEART

OF OLD LE MANS in Cité Plantagenêt


What's behind the name Plantagenet? Originally, Geoffrey V, known as Geoffrey the Fair, used to plant a branch of broom (genêt) on his headgear before going to war or hunting in the surrounding countryside to avoid being accidentally injured or killed by his own men. The name «Plantagenêt» was adopted by his descendants and left its mark on the city of Le Mans: the Palace of the Counts of Maine (now the Town Hall) was an important residence that regularly hosted members of this dynasty throughout history.




Cité Plantagenêt (Plantagenet City) refers to the historic district enclosed by **the Roman wall** built in the 3rd and 4th centuries. All these streets are overlooked by **the Saint-Julien Cathedral**, built from the 11th to the 15th century. It's an amazing district due to the rich variety of its facades (more than a hundred **half-timbered houses** and many private mansions built from the Renaissance to the classical period). This historic setting has for several years hosted the shooting of numerous historical, swashbuckling films: Cyrano de Bergerac, The Hunchback, The Gallant Ladies, The Man in the Iron Mask, Jean de La Fontaine, Molière, certain episodes of Nicolas Le Floch, etc.

• THE ROMAN walls

The Roman walls of Le Mans were built during the Late Roman Empire. Their construction of bricks and roussard stones bound with pink mortar gives the walls their characteristic hue. Vindunum (Le Mans) was called the «red city», in reference to the colour of its walls. It was built to assert imperial power: the exceptional richness of the facings, where geometric friezes still follow one after the other over 8 metres high, provides a wonderful example of this. A rare monument, unique in France, the wall is still standing, although with no real foundations. Twelve towers, a gate and three posterns can still be seen.

● Chœur gothique

● CATHEDRAL Saint-Julien

Initially dedicated to the Virgin and Saints Gervais and Protais, this building took the name Saint-Julien back in the 9th century. Divided into two styles - Romanesque and Gothic - the cathedral is a true history book for visitors.

Built in the 11th and 12th centuries, on ancient foundations, the nave contains a set of vaults known as Plantagenet style, created during a period of transition between styles at the end of the Romanesque and beginning of the Gothic periods. Heralded in the 12th century as «the most beautiful church in the West» by Bishop Hildebert de Lavardin, it provided the scene of numerous events: Geoffrey V, known as the Fair, the first member of the long Plantagenet dynasty, married Matilda here, one of William the Conqueror's granddaughters. The future King of England, Henry II Plantagenet, was baptised here and had a mausoleum built in memory of his late father.

The Gothic-style choir dates from the 13th century, comprising a crown of thirteen radiating chapels, opening onto a double ambulatory. The exceptional radiating chapel is buttressed by a beautiful set of simple flying buttresses, as well as inverted Y-shaped ones. The transept completed the construction in two stages: in the 14th and 15th centuries.





The heritage items are particularly varied: stained-glass window of the Ascension (circa 11th-12th century) located in the nave alongside a beautiful collection of stained-glass windows of various styles (12th-20th century); large Renaissance-style organs; monumental paintings of musician angels decorating the chapel of the Virgin; terracotta dating from the 17th and 18th centuries. The 21st century hasn't been forgotten, since the Christ in Glory made by the goldsmith Goudji has been installed at the entrance to the choir.

It was voted **"most beautiful cathedral in France"** in 2023 on the Henoo tourist app.

steps, you can admire, backing onto the Roman ramparts modified during the medieval period, **the Royal Collegiate Church of Saint-Pierre-la-Cour**, former chapel of **the Palace of the Counts of Maine** built between the 11th and 13th centuries. Its austere facades hide a low room with thin vaults, whose spans are interrupted by slender pillars. Not far from this building, on Rue Rostov-sur-le-Don, located under the School of Fine Arts, are the foundations of the Roman Baths destroyed in the 3rd century during the construction of the Roman walls. The steps continue along Rue des Ponts Neufs, where you'll encounter the city's particularly lively streets: cafés, bars, tea rooms, decoration shops, etc.

ROYAL COLLEGIATE CHURCH of St-Pierre-La-Cour

A few remains of the former Plantagenet Palace (1126-1240) still exist, incorporated into the building of Le Mans' current Town Hall. The palace complex was organised around two large noble hubs: the secular space (the count's hall) and ecclesiastical part (collegiate church of Saint Pierre-la-Cour). The hall (which featured a large ceremonial hall, now destroyed) served as a setting for the exercise of power and its representation. This is where ceremonies and feasts took place. Count Geoffrey Plantagenet and his wife Matilda, then the

powerful Henry II, their son, master of the English kingdom and western half of France, left their mark on this high place of public life. While it has retained its medieval appearance on Avenue Rostov sur le Don and Rue de la Comédie, the building has a classical L-shaped façade with a triangular pediment on the wing set at right angles facing Place Saint-Pierre. The hall hosts temporary exhibitions.





République DISTRICT

Place de la République (formerly Place des Halles) has been the heart of the city since its creation. Lined with former hotels, banks, shops, cafes, brasseries and the Chapel of the Visitation, this very airy, lively square invites us to stop and enjoy the sun on the terrace of a cafe or restaurant. It's accessible by tram or on foot.

Rue des Minimes is a major commercial artery. Here, you can admire the two department stores that have been awarded the 20th Century label.



• Là VISITATION

The Visitation Monastery was built by Mathurin Riballier under the direction of a Visitandine nun, Sister Anne-Victoire Pillon. The chapel was built between 1723 and 1737.

This iconic site has recently been redeveloped. Located in the heart of the city, Là Visitation offers a unique experience. Take the time to explore its shops, crafts, bars and restaurants. A timeless place where you'll enjoy coming back time and time again!

• THE CONTEMPORARY ART CENTRE FIAA Là Visitation

The FIAA is a venue for presenting contemporary art in Le Mans, right in the heart of the city. Exhibitions last between 2 and 3 months, and workshops are led by artists for every type of audience. The International Fund for Contemporary Art (FIAA) is an art centre with international reach located on the site of Là Visitation, focusing on current art. Aimed at art lovers, novices and enthusiasts alike, the FIAA regularly offers its spaces for temporary exhibitions that are renewed approximately every three months. These venues also offer activities as part of artist residencies, a documentary space, and workshops for everyone.



CHURCH of Notre-Dame de la Couture

Close to the Prefecture, **the Church of Notre-Dame de La Couture** is the former abbey church of the Benedictine monastery of Saint-Pierre-Saint-Paul de La Couture, founded in the 7th century by Bishop Saint-Bertrand. This Gothic-style religious building has very interesting altarpieces (17th, 18th and 19th centuries). In the nave, there's a «copy» of the Virgin and Child sculpted by Germain Pilon, a famous artist during the Renaissance, and paintings by Parrocel. The original sculpture by Germain Pilon is kept in a secure part of the building.

• CHURCH of Notre-Dame du Pré

The Church of Notre-Dame du Pré (formerly Saint-Julien du Pré), on Place du Pré, is a superb Romanesque church dating from the 11th and 12th centuries, enlarged in the 19th century by architect Denis Darcy, a student and co-worker of Viollet-Le-Duc, a renowned Parisian architect. It was part of an abbey enclosure, destroyed during the Revolution.



• CHAPEL of the Oratory

Located in the old suburbs of the city (Saint-Vincent district), the Chapel of the Oratory currently belongs to the Montesquieu high school. It boasts charming architecture with a choir topped by a Baroque-style canopy.

THE HOTEL-DIEU of Coëffort

Coëffort's Hôtel-Dieu was built in the 12th century on the orders of King Henry II Plantagenet, King of England, to accommodate the poor, sick, abandoned children and pilgrims. The exterior appears quite solid and without decoration, yet it actually conceals some very fine architecture. Beautiful paintings can also be discovered inside. The church is open for services and guided tours. In 1953, the «treasure of Coëffort», consisting of 31 pieces of medieval civil silverware, was discovered during work to renovate the building. This very sober silver tableware was used by the hospital brethren of the Hôtel Dieu Coëffort, in the 14th and 15th centuries. During the Hundred Years War, the silverware was buried and then forgotten...

This treasure is currently on display at the Jean Claude Boulard-Carré Plantagenêt Museum.

ROYAL ABBEY of Épau

Listed as a Historic Monument, the Royal Abbey of Épau is one of the finest examples of Cistercian architecture in France. This gem was founded in 1230 by Berengaria of Navarre, widow of Richard the Lionheart, whose recumbent statue is on display within the abbey church. The

abbey became the property of the Department of Sarthe in 1959. A vast restoration programme, still underway, has given it a new lease of life, making the abbey one of the cultural highlights of Sarthe.

Since 2017, the Department of Sarthe has sought to restore the abbey garden's historical dimension while paying close attention to current environmental issues. A conservation orchard has been created. Beehives have also been set up. A vegetable garden has been created to the north of the church, with a pond and greenhouse added to the development of the permaculture garden. There's also a chicken coop, which is home to around a dozen hens. Since 2021, La Forêt Nourricière has been supplying part of the «Café des Moines» restaurant, opened in 2017.

The cultural programme now includes several events: music festivals (jazz, classical and electro), temporary exhibitions (photography, comics, painting, etc.), workshops for young people, concerts, events, guided tours, as well as the end-of-year light and sound journey.

• Jean-Claude-Boulard CARRÉ PLANTAGENÊT MUSEUM

At the junction of Cité Plantagenêt and the new town stands the Jean-Claude-Boulard Carré Plantagenêt Museum, which displays collections of archaeological and historical items. This building combines contemporary architecture with ancient buildings. In this unique setting, visitors who step inside are offered a journey through time and history. Highlights include the Coëffort treasure and Plantagenêt enamel.

• Tessé MUSEUM


Located in a beautiful wooded park near the Cité Plantagenêt, the Tessé Museum (or Museum of Fine Arts) in Le Mans occupies the site of the former Tessé family estate. The exhibition route, organised around paintings and sculptures from the 14th to the 20th century, invites visitors to discover Italian primitives, Caravaggio painters and French classics from the 17th century. The Tessé Museum is dedicated to ancient Egypt, a surprising, unique space in France.

An association of enthusiasts invites you to visit the perfectly preserved 7th German Army blockhouse in Le Mans. Protected within the Berthelot College grounds, the building has escaped squatting and looting and remains virtually intact. Unlike bunkers located on the coast, this blockhouse hasn't suffered damage from sea air or shifting sand.

• The Western **CEMETERY**

The largest cemetery is certainly the Grand Cimetière built in 1834, located at 182 Avenue François Chancel. Originally, it covered an area of 3 hectares, before being enlarged following the growing demands of families, as well as the pace of world conflicts (1870-1871; 1914-1918; 1939-1945). A true city within the city, it's interesting for its many sculpted funerary chapels, equipped with magnificent stained-glass windows and its decorated tombs. City mayors, local politicians, artists from all walks of life and scientific figures who left their mark on their times are all buried here, bearing witness to the very rich history of Le Mans. This cemetery, also nicknamed the Cimetière de l'Ouest (Western Cemetery), has the largest military square in western France, where soldiers of all nationalities are buried.

● **Sainte-Croix
CEMETERY**

This town was both rural, an industrial site and a holiday spot. The families of Le Mans' notables were buried in this modest cemetery: members of the Bollée family, the aunts of writer Antoine de Saint-Exupéry, religious congregations and artists shared these places where respect is required.

The Sainte-Croix Cemetery was the cemetery of the former town of Sainte-Croix. Having become an integral part of Le Mans, this





Two rivers run through the Le Mans metropolitan area: the Sarthe and the Huisne.


Overlooked by an elongated hill, the Sarthe was a feature that attracted the Aulerici Cenomani and then the Romans who, as well as ancient civil and religious monuments, built the Roman wall in the 3rd and 4th centuries. In the Middle Ages, numerous bridges, made of wood or stone, spanned the two banks of the Sarthe, bringing economic interest to the city. In the 19th century, the banks of the Sarthe underwent major embankment work to alleviate the all-too-regular flooding problems. Currently, the banks offer plenty of ideas for walks, thanks to the landscaped parks and gardens (Île aux Planches Park, Gué-de-Maulny Park and the Allée des Pêcheurs, and the Towpath Promenade, for example).

Private and public gardens take pride of place in Le Mans! True green lungs, these open spaces are everywhere in the city on both banks of the Sarthe.

• The plant **GARDEN**

On Rue Prémartine, designed by Jean Charles Alphand, creator of the Bois de Boulogne, Bois de Vincennes and Parc Montsouris in Paris. Created at the behest of the Sarthe Horticultural Society, it consists of two distinct parts: the regular garden, known as the French garden (with its rose garden), and the landscaped garden, known as the English garden (with a pond).

• Tessé **PARK**

On Avenue de Paderborn stands one of the oldest parks in the city. Attached since the 17th century to the former Hôtel de Lavardin and then Hôtel de Tessé (now the Tessé Museum), this park covers an area of 2.3 hectares and has a pond and lots of flower beds. In the 1920s, it was redesigned as an English-style park. Since 2009, the giant hourglass, «Le Temps impari-Eclipse 1999-2001», created by Jean-Bernard Métais, to celebrate the passing to the year 2000, has decorated the garden and is one of the city's treasures.



• L'ÎLE aux Planches

ÎLE AUX PLANCHES (along the Sarthe) is an island of greenery created in 2008. On the Greffier Bridge, the statue «l'Envol», dedicated to the beginnings of aviation in the region, was created by sculptor Paul Landowski, the man behind «Christ the Redeemer» in Rio de Janeiro.



• The Pierre-de-Ronsard GARDEN

The Pierre-de-Ronsard GARDENS (west of the Ponts Neufs steps) and Jacques Peletier Gardens (east of these same steps), on Avenue Rostov-sur-le-Don, bring different colourful notes to each season, at the foot of the walls and town hall.


• The Poets' GARDENS

The POETS' GARDENS, on Avenue Rostov-sur-le-Don, add colour to the city walls and town hall in every season.




• The Banjan PARK

• THE QUINCONCES des Jacobins


The Quinconces des Jacobins and Promenade des Cordeliers, behind the Le Mans Quinconces complex, have been there since the end of the 18th century following the disappearance of the religious enclosures during the Revolution. The development work revealed the remains of the Roman amphitheatre, which explains the names of the neighbouring streets: Rue des Arènes (Arena), Rue des Gladiateurs, Rue du Cirque (Circus). Inaugurated in 1811, this promenade lined with lime trees is very popular with the residents and visitors passing through Le Mans.

• Théodore-Monod PARK

Théodore-Monod Park is popular all year round. In summer, its water features allow young and old alike to cool off.

Its many trees, nearly 185 in total and 19 different species, as well as its rose-covered pergola, make it a shady place where it's nice to come for a stroll. In summer, numerous exhibitions and festivals are hosted here, making this garden a lively, attractive place for the locals.

This park, near the hospital, contains the remains of the former Chanzy barracks and includes two hectares of greenery.

• The Gourdaine and Tanneries GARDENS

• ARCHE de la Nature

Located ten minutes from the heart of Le Mans, Arche de la Nature offers visitors a vast natural space. Along its paths, walkers can discover the river, wooded countryside and forest, and can visit Maison de l'Eau, Maison de la Forêt and Maison de la Prairie (garden and farm). In total, there are 500 hectares of nature accessible to the public free of charge at all times.

• MAISON de la Forêt

Discover the riches of the forest (animals and plants) in an interactive, sensory way. Over an area of 180 m², by following a forest path, visitors can discover the many wild animals (living or stuffed) and plant species. From the observatory where a film is projected to interactive, sensory terminals and mystery installations (touch, insects, etc.), the forest is covered from a variety of angles. The wood industry (logging, woodworking trades) is also addressed through models and games. The Maison de la Forêt is located on the Arche de la Nature site, on the D152 road between Le Mans and Changé.

• MAISON de l'Eau

Maison de l'Eau is one of the access points to the Arche de la Nature estate, accessible by tram. Located near the Huisne, it contains large aquariums where visitors can learn about the river's different ecosystems: the trout zone, barbel zone and bream zone. Other aquariums bring together smaller species: minnows, bullheads, gudgeon, etc. Three five-metre-long aquariums present around twenty fish from our rivers. A visit to the old waterworks takes visitors through the history of treating river water to provide drinking water. You can see the old steam engines and water wheels that today produce electricity in operation. Upstairs, an exhibition room with interactive fresco and several thematic modules mean visitors can explore water in all its aspects. A permanent exhibition provides visitors with information about energy sources in a fun way. The Maison de l'Eau is now protected as a historic monument.

• MAISON DE LA PRAIRIE

Farm and vegetable garden

Maison de la Prairie is home to many breeds from the north-west of France, including some unusual ones: the La Flèche hen, Poitou donkey, Pie Noire Breton cow, Belle-Île sheep, etc. Its 2100 m² vegetable garden offers a variety of vegetables and presents different gardening techniques: growing on mounds, mulching and plant cover, keyhole gardening, etc.



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

• The Drivers' Handprints **ROUTE**

This initiative was launched in 1991 in the Saint-Nicolas district. The 43 plaques with the handprints of the winning drivers of the 24 Hours are now positioned along a route, on the pavements of Avenue du Général Leclerc. The inauguration took place during the celebrations to mark the centenary of the 24 Hours of Le Mans on 3 June 2023.



• AIGNÉ



Located about ten kilometres from Le Mans, this rural town has existed since the Middle Ages, established along a route leading to Mont-Saint-Michel. The Church of the Assumption preserves archaeological traces from different periods, notably the 12th to the 20th centuries. Its furnishings include a magnificent altarpiece, a wooden Pietà dating from the 14th or 15th century, restored to its original colours, and terracotta statues from the 18th century.

• ALLONNES

Allonnes boasts 2500 years of history. The Gallo-Roman sanctuary dedicated to Mars-Mullo, built on the mound of the Tour aux Fées, is an illustration of this. Archaeological excavations have revealed a flourishing Gallic period from the 4th century.

The Church of Saint-Martin, founded in the 11th century, houses a listed 18th-century altarpiece and remarkable stained-glass windows. The end of the 19th century saw the construction of Château de la Foréterie by Gustave Avice, mayor of Allonnes from 1899 to 1913. The site was home to many renowned artists in the early 20th century.


The town hall, designed by architect Jean Le Couteur, is symbolic of the new urbanisation of the 1970s.





ARNAGE

Arnage became an independent town in 1853 and prospered thanks to passing trade and its port on the Sarthe. The Church of Saint-Gilles, whose history dates back to the 12th century, is the town's oldest heritage building. In 1886, Auguste Bollée, a member of the illustrious Le Mans family, had a country house built with ponds, waterfalls and a windmill, still visible today from the towpath along the Sarthe. Arnage also owes its renown to the famous bend of the 24 Hours of Le Mans. Arnage is a dynamic town, blending heritage and nature, with its landscaped green spaces along the Sarthe and the Gèmerie Lake, offering a pleasant setting for residents and visitors.

CHAMPAGNÉ

A vibrant countryside town on the outskirts of Le Mans, Champagné offers visitors a rural setting with the Huisne River and its nature park, wooded areas and the preserved built heritage of the town centre (Church of Saint-Désiré, Château de Réveillon and Château des Aubrys). Its history is marked by Wilbur Wright's first flights, making it a global cradle of aviation, and by Jean Rondeau, the only racing driver to have built his own vehicle and won the 24 Hours of Le Mans.

Palm Sunday sees the Fête des Lances take place, a medieval tradition. Other festivities are held throughout the year: the Music Festival, fireworks and entertainment, and the Christmas Market.



CHAUFOUR- NOTRE-DAME

Its name comes from the ancient activity based on lime kilns. The town stands on the edge of the ancient Le Mans-Jublains Roman road. Archaeological discoveries (pottery, coins) attest to this history. Notre Dame Church also has interesting furnishings (altarpieces, baptismal fonts).

FATINES

Not much is known about the history of this small town near Le Mans. In the Middle Ages, the village bordered one of the routes leading to Santiago de Compostela, which would explain the choice of the church's patron saint. Built in the 11th and 12th centuries, the church has a single nave covered with an exposed wooden frame and panelling. Along the wall of the nave is a pulpit-confessional, a rare heritage piece in the department, designed in 1785. The rural town has several buildings that bear witness to significant religious and public activity: the presbytery, built in the 12th century and enlarged in the 16th and 19th centuries, the André-Grassin school and town hall.

• FAY

Dating back to the early days of the village, a Gallo-Roman villa and its pottery have been discovered. The 11th-century church would later form its urban core. The Revolution saw violent republican clashes with the Vendéens. According to legend, the

wooden altarpiece of the Church of Saint-Pierre-Saint-Paul came from the Hôtel-Dieu of Coëffort.

This small piece of heritage, a witness to a bygone era, can still be seen (washhouse, calvaries, hemp kiln).

• LA CHAPELLE-SAINT-AUBIN


Crossed by the old Mons road during the Middle Ages, then bordered by the old royal road leading to Alençon, the region was placed under the authority of the chapter of Saint-Julien du Mans.

Throughout its existence, the town saw the construction of new buildings, monuments and other sites (leprosy house and its cross, wells, roussard cross, farm, calvary, etc.). In August 1944, the future Marshal Leclerc de Hautecloque, at the head of the 2nd Armoured Division, passed through the town and stayed the night there.

In the 1970s, the town began its transformation, expanding with the development of a large industrial and commercial zone.



• COULAINES

With nearly 2000 years of history, Coulaines takes its name from the Gallo-Roman era. Formerly known as «Villa Colonia», it was an important fiefdom of the first bishops of Le Mans. In 843, Charles II, grandson of Charlemagne, signed the Capitulary of Coulaines, a treaty that gave rise to the feudal system. The Church of Saint-Nicolas, dating from the 11th century and listed as a historic monument, houses, among other things, a figurative stained-glass window dating from the 19th century. Coulaines became a place of relaxation for the people of Le Mans in the 18th century, and from the 20th century onward, the town became more densely populated. Today, its 15 km of sunken lanes, major hard-boiled egg festival, swimming pool, padel and tennis courts, stadium and numerous labels (good-life town, golden flower town, most sporting town) bear witness to a dynamic place looking firmly to the future.

• LA MILESSE

The village dates back to the Roman period and was established along an ancient communication route. The Church of Saint-Pierre, founded in the 11th century, is characterised by the presence of roussard sandstone rubble, a vernacular (traditional) material from Maine.

• MULSANNE

Famous in the world of the 24-Hour Race for its famous bend and surrounded by pine trees, the town is located south of Le Mans, along the old 18th-century royal road towards Tours.

The population grew especially towards the end of the 20th century.



• PRUIILLÉ-LE-CHÉTIF

Ancient texts indicate the presence of a Roman villa in this area. During the Middle Ages, the bishops owned land and outbuildings here. The village grew massively during the 19th century. The Church of Saint-Pierre, founded in the 12th century, was greatly enlarged in the 19th century. The heritage from the 18th and 19th centuries is particularly important here (château, manors, notables' houses) as well as varied (calvary, cross, wash house, hemp kiln, Bollée windmill).



• ROUILLOON


One of Vindinum's aqueducts passed through its lands to supply the town with water. As early as the 15th century, a castle belonging to the Nepveu family, Lords of Rouillon, was built, a true highlight of

the town which led to a real fondness for the village. A presbytery, manors, farms, a hemp kiln, and the Vaujoubert-Notre Dame Carmelite convent can be found throughout the town.

• RUAUDIN

Ruaudin, a charming Sarthe village, boasts remarkable architectural and natural heritage. The Church of Saint-Pierre, dating from the 17th, 19th and 20th centuries, houses some magnificent stained-glass windows to delight lovers of sacred art. The washhouse, restored in 1986 by volunteers, demonstrates the importance of water in local life. The numerous hiking trails that wind through the forest, covering a large part of the area, mean walkers can discover the richness of the local flora and fauna. Ruaudin is the perfect destination for heritage and nature lovers, who'll find a place of relaxation and discovery.

• SAINT-GEORGES-DU-BOIS

The medieval church was part of the former Benedictine abbey of Saint Julien du Pré du Mans. During the post-revolutionary period, the village served as a gathering place for Vendée troops before their departure for Le Mans.

Also worthy of note within the church is the presence of various statues representing Saint George and a Virgin and Child. A series of small fountains gave their name to a street, demonstrating the importance of water in this village.



• SAINT-SATURNIN

Owned by Bishop Sigefroy during the Middle Ages, Saint-Saturnin fell into the hands of the lords of Milesse. The church was built following the vagaries of local history (from the 10th to the 18th century). In this scattered region, the vernacular heritage is of great importance (bread oven, hemp oven, cross and calvary in roussard sandstone, typical plank work).

SARGÉ-LES-LE-MANS

Sargé-Lès-Le-Mans gradually developed along the old road leading to Rouen. From the site known as Fontenelles (a dependent of Sargé), numerous springs were captured and then channelled by a Roman aqueduct towards Vindinum (Le Mans during the Late Roman Empire) to supply water to the town and its ancient monuments. In the Middle Ages, the fief of Sargé was dependent on the bishopric of Le Mans. With its numerous vineyards, the town supplied the locals with wine, which was used in the inhabitants' daily meals. The Church of Saint-Aubin contains some interesting furnishings, with its magnificent 16th-century altarpiece, erected under Henry III. Along one of its outside walls, you'll find tombstones from the old 14th-century cemetery. Passing through Sargé, the Le Mans - Bonnétable railway line was active from 1897 until 1947, and its operation was transferred to the Compagnie des Tramways de la Sarthe.

TRANGÉ


In the Middle Ages, the parish depended on the chapter of Saint-Julien Cathedral. The church dedicated to Saint-Gervais and Saint Protais (12th or 13th century) stands away from the rest of the village. Its small cemetery is attached to it. Its originality lies in its bell-wall, probably dating from the 17th century. By its etymology, Château de la Groirie (17th and 18th centuries) indicates that its original owner was responsible for overseeing and exploiting the woods and forests. Legend suggests that it was here that the rule founding the monastic life of La Trappe was born.

YVRÉ-L'ÉVÈQUE

From the 11th century onwards, the bishops' stays became so frequent that the village adopted its current name and then became an important place of residence for the diocese of Le Mans, particularly under the episcopate of Louis de Grimaldi. The Church of Saint-Germain has the particular feature of consisting of a choir covered with Plantagenet-style vaults dating from the 12th century, as well as stained-glass windows depicting the 1871 battle on the Auvours plateau. Indeed, on 11 January 1871, Auvours Hill was the scene of a terrible battle between Chanzy's army and the Prussians. A monument commemorates this battle. Around a hundred soldiers who died in

combat, as well as General Gougeard, are buried there in a crypt beneath the monument. Housing the recumbent statue of Berengaria of Navarre, widow of Richard the Lionheart, the Cistercian abbey of Épau is part of the town of Yvré l'Évêque and belongs to the Sarthe Departmental Council.

● Pont Romain CAMPsite

Located 10 minutes from Le Mans and its famous circuit, and close to the Pôle Européen du Cheval (European Horse Centre), the Pont Romain campsite offers empty pitches, campervan pitches, high-end rentals and all the services you need for a comfortable stay in a lush setting. The campsite has been awarded the Green Key label and is part of an approach promoting sustainable tourism. Also holding the Accueil Vélo label for cyclists, it serves as a stopover point for cycle tourists who want to discover the region by taking the various cycle routes such as the Vélobuissonnière and Boulevard Nature.







With more than 100 events hosted each year, the life of Stade Marie Marvingt revolves around professional sport, national and international events, seminars and conventions, motor sports and local community life.


Marie Marvingt (1875-1963), nicknamed «danger's fiancée», became famous before the First World War for her many exploits in sports such as mountaineering, cycling, target shooting, swimming and many more besides, especially winter sports. Her many commitments and exploits made her a great personality, with strong values and convictions, which justify the city of Le Mans paying tribute to her. She is an example in many ways: accomplished sportswoman, doyenne of female aviators, inventor in medical aviation, nurse, and even an infantry member during the First World War, journalist and lecturer.

Le Mans' stadium is the first sports arena in France with more than 20 000 seats to bear the name of a woman.






